

Bail denied for tool thief suspect



A twenty-seven-year-old man was denied bail by the Phoenix Magistrate's Court after he was arrested of stealing tools.

The complainant alleges that Eugene Chetty entered his premises, went to the garage and stole a tool box with various of tools inside. Chetty allegedly tried to leave but was caught by the owner with the help of his neighbours. The police were called and the suspect was arrested. In a bid to get bail, Chetty submitted a sworn statement, which was read by his defence attorney, Mr Mncube from Legal Aid South Africa. Mncube submitted his client's personal circumstances and that he was a Phoenix resident, which falls under the court's jurisdiction. Chetty had no travelling documents, which meant he was not a flight risk. He was not intending to interfere with the police investigations. The bail applicant was also willing to abide by any bail conditions set by the court. Mncube told the court that Chetty intended to plead not guilty to the crime as he did not steal from anyone. According to Mncube, Chetty was passing by the complainant's house, when he (the complainant) called Chetty by name and invited him to come inside his premises. He then assaulted him, accusing him of stealing his tools. Chetty sustained scratches on his elbows, bruising on his ribs and lower back. Mncube asked the court to release Chetty on warning as he had no money for bail.

The state prosecutor, Mr Govender, opposed bail, citing that the Investigating Officer had warned him that Chetty had been linked to other crimes which were still under investigation. Govender was worried that if Chetty was released he would not avail himself for trial. In handing down the sentence, Magistrate Parshotam considered Chetty's personal circumstances and found that it was not in the interest of society to release him on bail as he had the propensity to commit more crime if released. Thus, the magistrate denied Chetty bail. The matter was adjourned to 05 October 2017 for further investigations.
