Sharks sink Bulls at wet Kings Park



The Sharks brought their Currie Cup winning streak to nine matches when they beat the Blue Bulls at a wet Kings Park on Saturday.

The hosts won 18-5, after leading 12-0 at the break. In a game played in treacherous conditions, the Sharks outscored their opponents by two tries to one, with the boot of flyhalf Curwin Bosch also proving vital pints. Bosch orchestrated winger S'busiso Nkosi's first half try with a clever cross-kick, while a second half drop goal contributed to his man-of-the-match accolade.

The Sharks' victory has taken them 13 points clear at the top of the standings and also secured a home semi-final. They have won nine out of 10 games, with their only loss coming in Round 1 when they sent a second-string outfit to Bloemfontein to duel the Free State Cheetahs. The Bulls, meanwhile, have won just three out of nine games and sit second from bottom and are unlikely to make the play-offs.

In next weekend's action, the Sharks host the Golden Lions in Durban (Friday, September 29 - 19H15), while the Blue Bulls entertain Western Province in Pretoria (Sunday, October 1 - 14:30).
